


**THE FRIDAY NIGHT FEEL-GOOD MOVIES!!

With the help of Diana's twin brother (Tom Hollander) and the groundbreaking ideas of inventor Teddy Hall (Hugh Bonneville), Robin and Diana dare to escape the hospital ward to seek out a full and passionate life together - raising their young son, traveling and devoting their lives to helping other polio patients. <i>BREATHE</i> is a heartwarming celebration of love and human possibility</p>
	<p align="center"><b>MAY 25<sup>th</sup> 2018 @ 7.00 pm</b></p> <p><i>Victoria and Abdul</i> is the extraordinary true story of an unexpected friendship in the later years of Queen Victoria's (Academy Award winner Judi Dench) remarkable rule. When Abdul Karim (Ali Fazal), a young clerk, travels from India to participate in the Queen's Golden Jubilee, he is surprised to find favor with the Queen herself. As the Queen questions the constrictions of her long-held position, the two forge an unlikely and devoted alliance with a loyalty to one another that her household and inner circle all attempt to destroy. As the friendship deepens, the Queen begins to see a changing world through new eyes and joyfully reclaims her humanity.</p>
